Position Description

Cristo Rey Philadelphia High School is seeking a Geometry teacher for a full time position in the 2021-2022 school year. Candidates should have an appreciation of the school's mission and a commitment to the values of Catholic education. This position will begin full-time work in February/March of 2021. All Cristo Rey Classes are currently virtual, but we hope to return to a hybrid model when it is safe.

Responsibilities

Instructional Practice & Student Development

- Plan for instruction of assigned courses in the content area by developing annual, unit, and lesson plans aligned with the network's standards-based curriculum and the individual needs of their students.
- Set high expectations for student development. Ensure all students develop grade-level proficiency. Prepare all students for success in college. Integrate character and leadership development into curriculum. Help each young man and woman develop into a leader who serves God and society.
- Support academic, social, emotional, spiritual, and physical development of every student. Promote student development of the whole person — mind, body, and spirit.
- Differentiate instruction to allow students with differing learning styles to access course content. Utilize classroom technology to engage students' learning.
- Develop interim benchmarks and assessments linked to course standards and work with other faculty and administrators to analyze results and refocus instruction based on student needs.
- Identify and remediate subject matter in which students require additional support.

Outside the Classroom

• Communicate regularly with parents/families to share academic progress and develop a supportive home-school relationship.

Collaboration

- Understand and appreciate the developmental and educational benefits of the school's corporate work study program.
- Develop relationships with and meet the individual needs of each student consistent with the school's belief in *cura personalis*, or "care for the whole individual." Provide feedback and support to the *cura personalis* committee and counseling team to identify and support

students who are struggling behaviorally or emotionally.

• Participate in grade-level meetings to coordinate curriculum across the content area and better understand student needs.

Organization-wide Learning & Development

- Understand your own teaching practice as developmental. Tap into available resources from colleagues and external sources to continually reflect on and improve your teaching.
- Participate in the school's professional learning community, collaborating with colleagues to analyze student work and teaching practice. Help to create a reflective learning organization for both students and adults. Serve as a catalyst for improvement in your own classroom and school-wide.
