## CRPHS Community Expectations

The priority of Cristo Rey Philadelphia High School is *cura personalis*, or care for the whole person, and this extends to our community as well. Our goal is for every member of our school community to understand the responsibility we have for each other and that we all have a role to play in providing for the health and safety of our community. It is up to each of us to conscientiously do our part to protect each other. With the well-being of each member of the school community in mind, we are all committed to:

**ADHERE TO REQUIRED SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND RISK MITIGATION MEASURES WHILE ON CAMPUS.** I will follow the precautions, which include wearing a mask, practicing social distancing, proper hand washing, and respiratory etiquette (e.g. covering my cough or sneeze), so that I will contribute to the health and safety of others.

**TO PARTICIPATE IN DAILY SELF-CARE AND ASSESSMENT PROTOCOLS AS REQUIRED.** I will monitor my health status honestly and accurately each day by performing a self-screening and will follow all screening protocols when entering the building.

**TO STAY HOME IF I AM SICK.** If I have COVID-19 symptoms or know that I have had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, I will not come onto campus.

**TO COMMUNICATE TRANSPARENTLY.** I will report any developments that may be important to assist in promoting the health and safety of the school community, including sharing positive COVID-19 test results for me or a member of my household.

**TO PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS WHEN NOT ON CAMPUS.** Recognizing that some people without symptoms may be able to spread the virus, I will avoid crowded places and mass gatherings. I will follow the CDC guidelines and other governmental restrictions in order to promote the health and safety of our community.

**TO OBSERVE SPACE RESTRICTIONS.** I will keep space between myself and others while on campus and will adhere to the guidelines for the use of space on campus.

**TO BE FLEXIBLE.** The school will remain in regular communication with faculty, staff, parents, guardians and students. This guide, and any changes and updates to it, will be shared with the entire Cristo Rey Philadelphia community through direct messages and on the COVID-19 Resource page on our school website

## Proactive Prevention

**Face Masks:** Face masks are an important part of employee and student protection, as well as personal hygiene, social distancing, and frequent cleaning efforts. Face masks are required to be worn throughout the building and anytime you are in the same space as other adults or students.

- (1) Washable cloth mask will be provided to all faculty and staff that are consistently in the building
- (1) Washable cloth mask will be provided to all students

Masks are required for all visitors. Disposable masks will be available for visitors. Outside masks are welcome but must cover the mouth and nose and may not have any offensive messaging on them. Gators and bandanas do not qualify as masks.

Teachers will be provided with face shields as an added level of protection, but a face mask must still be worn with the shield.

Failure to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth will result in asking the person to leave and not return to the school building until they are able to follow all safety and health protocols.

**Hand Hygiene:** Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available. Hand Sanitizer Stations are located on every floor and at main entry/exit points. Hand Sanitizer and wipes will be available in every classroom. Everyone should avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth

**Social Distancing:** CRPHS employees and students should practice staying approximately 6 feet away from other persons and eliminating contact with others. Students will sit six feet apart. There is a 6 foot wide, at least, section along the entire front of each classroom to give teachers space to get up and move while maintaining a safe distance from seated students and for anyone entering or exiting the room to do so with proper social distancing.

- Signage on the floor will mark the walking direction throughout the school in order to maintain the social distancing requirement of 6 feet.
- Non-essential/informal meetups and visiting is not permitted. Large group gatherings in common spaces is not permitted if social distancing is not possible.

**Lockers:** Lockers will not be used during the Hybrid Learning Model. Students must have a backpack to carry all school day items from class to class.

**Entry/Departure:** At the start of school students will get their temperature taken and go directly to their assigned classroom. At the end of the day students will leave their assigned classroom at the designated time and immediately leave the building. No informal gathering in hallways or common areas.

**Lunch:** Students will sit in assigned socially distant locations in the social hall and gym to eat a boxed lunch provided for them.

## **Employee & Student Screening Protocols**

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and other illnesses and to reduce the potential risk of exposure to students and employees, all persons entering the school building will be required to complete a temperature scan and a self-screening for following the COVID-19 symptoms: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 degrees, known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19.

All persons entering the building must affirm that they do not currently have these symptoms. If a student entering the building has these symptoms, he/she/they will be immediately escorted to the identified Isolation Room awaiting to be picked-up by a parent or guardian. If an adult entering the building has any of these symptoms, he/she/they will be asked to leave the building.

### **Student Health Protocol**

Should any student attending school in-person test positive for COVID-19, the student should contact the school immediately and that student's entire cohort, including teachers, will quarantine at home for ten (10) days. The infected student may return to school when the following criteria are met:

- Has quarantined for ten (10) days;
- At least 24 hours have passed since recovery (no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications);
- Improved respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, etc);
- At least 7 days have passed since symptoms first occurred.

Should someone who lives in a student's household test positive for COVID-19, the school should be contacted immediately to report the test results, and then the student must be quarantined at home for ten (10) days.

### **Employee Health Protocol**

If an employee has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the employee must contact their supervisor and HR immediately to report the test results. If the employee is a member of the faculty, that teacher's grade level and anyone in close contact with that faculty member will quarantine for ten (10) days. If the employee is a member of the staff, those who have been in contact with the staff member will be asked to quarantine. That employee may return to work when these criteria are met:

- Has quarantined for ten (10) days;
- At least 24 hours have passed since recovery (no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications);
- Improved respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, etc);
- At least 7 days have passed since symptoms first occurred

If an employee has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and has not been evaluated by a medical professional or tested for COVID-19, the employee may not return to work until the criteria above have been met.

## Facilities Cleaning

The safety of our students and employees is our first priority. Upon reopening, the school will have been completely cleaned and disinfected and we will continue to adhere to all necessary safety precautions. The cleaning chart below outlines the steps that will be taken to disinfect the various areas of our facility to protect our community and to reduce the risk of spread of infection.

<b>AREA</b>	<b>FREQUENCY</b>
Classrooms & Offices	Daily & wiped down throughout the day
Bathrooms	2x per day & spot checked hourly
High Touch (e.g. handrails)	2x per day & spot checked hourly
Trash	Take to dumpster when exiting the building
