Health & Fitness Teacher Description

The health and fitness teacher at Cristo Rey works within the Physical education and health team and collaborates closely with the school counselors, teachers and the administrative team. The health teacher reports directly to the Principal.

Responsibilities:

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Develop grade appropriate health curriculum
- Teach five to six assigned health or fitness class periods
- Plan and prepare curriculum-based unit and lesson plans
- Work cooperatively with other physical education teachers in planning and implementing a balanced physical education and health program.
- Grade and record and provide feedback on student work
- Serve as a substitute teacher for absent teachers
- Prepare, correct and proctor assessments
- Participate in the instructional coaching program
- Serve as an advisor to a small group of students

- Serve as a moderator of student clubs/activities or coach of athletic teams as needed.
- Serve as a chaperone of field trips, retreats, and other activities.
- Attend conferences and orientations with students and parents
- Offer individual guidance to students
- Serve on faculty committees and observe other classrooms
- Study departmental and school data
- Attend faculty meetings, grade level meetings, content team meetings
- Serve as a catalyst for improvement in your own classroom and school-wide.
- Take part in school's religious and spiritual programs, including faculty and staff retreats.
